Merchant Marine Radio Operation

The March SARA meeting will feature a presentation by Lionel O. Barthold, will speak of his career as a merchant marine radio operator during WWII.

Starting while in high school as a cruise ship operator on the Great Lakes, his service included routes in the Caribbean, North Atlantic and Pacific zones. He will describe the duties of a radio operator in those days, the equipment used, and life aboard a merchantman ship during the 1940s when nearly all operations both routine and emergency was with morse code.

Mr. Barthold is the former CEO of Power Technologies, Inc. and long active in high voltage electric power transmission engineering, Lionel Barthold developed the first comprehensive theory of radio noise propagation from overhead power lines while working at GE in the 1950's. He was responsible for continuing experimental and analytical work on radio and audible noise from power lines as director of Project EHV, a GE high voltage laboratory in Pittsfield, in the 1960's.

The SARA Meeting will begin at 7 PM in Room D-104 "the Little Theater".

About The SARA Meeting Location

The normal SARA meeting location for 2008 is in Niskayuna High School's "Little Theater" Room D-104 which is on a cross hallway between the two wings in the rear of the school. This is about 150 feet down the hall and to the right of the old meeting location in "new cafeteria". Due to major school construction at the front main entrance of the school there are changes in parking and the traffic pattern for access to the rear parking lot. Access to the school's rear parking lot must be gained by entering from Nott Street which crosses Balltown just south of the school at the light. Go past shopping mall where Friendly's is a few hundred yards on Nott and go into the Niskayuna High School rear entrance which is marked on the left. This entrance leads to the parking lot on the side/rear of the school. As always SARA meetings are only held when Niskayuna High School has classes, so if there is a school closing that day or evening due to inclement weather check the K2AE repeater 147.06 or call one of the club officers on the phone or radio. Also remember there is no smoking on school premises.

Most of these highly effective antennas were originally designed by Kent Brittan WA5JVB for inexpensive and easy construction for ham bands from 2 meters through 1296. The best part is that you can make antennas for most of the VHF bands for just a few dollars each and even the feed arrangement is very simple and effective.
